

**RESOLUTION NO. 18-22**

**SUPPORTING KING GEORGE COUNTY AND CAROLINE COUNTY 2018 SMART SCALE  
PROJECT APPLICATIONS**

**WHEREAS**, the George Washington Regional Commission (“the Commission”) serves as the Planning District Commission for PD 16; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commonwealth of Virginia is accepting Smart Scale project applications from March 1, 2018 through July 31, 2018 for the Fiscal Years 2020-2025 Six-Year Improvement Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Smart Scale process requires localities to receive a resolution of support from their respective Metropolitan Planning Organization or Planning District Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, the deadline for submission of these resolutions is August 1, 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, King George County wishes to submit four applications and Caroline County wishes to submit two applications for this round of Smart Scale;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the George Washington Regional Commission that it hereby supports the following 2018 Smart Scale project applications:

1. US 301 and Route 3 median U-turn intersection (King George County);
2. Route 206 and Route 218 right turn lane (King George County);
3. US 301 and Commerce Drive pedestrian improvements (King George County);
4. US 301 and Route 206 median U-turn intersection (King George County);
5. I-95 Exit 104 interchange improvements (Caroline County); and
6. US 301 crossover consolidation/removal and conversion to a Restricted Crossing U-Turn Superstreet (Caroline County).

Adopted by the George Washington Regional Commission at its duly called meeting on June 18, 2018, in the City of Fredericksburg, Virginia, a quorum being present.
