

**RESOLUTION NO. 20-08**

**ENDORING THE FISCAL YEAR 2021 RURAL TRANSPORTATION PLANNING  
WORK PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the George Washington Regional Commission (“the Commission”) is the Planning District Commission serving the City of Fredericksburg and Caroline, King George, Spotsylvania and Stafford counties, known together as Planning District 16; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission recognizes the need to conduct transportation planning activities in its rural areas; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission’s staff, working with the Fredericksburg Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (FAMPO) Technical Advisory Committee (TAC), has developed a Rural Transportation Planning Work Program for Fiscal Year 2021 to benefit the non-urbanized portions of Planning District 16; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission agrees to provide the required 20 percent match of \$14,500 for the \$58,000 in State Planning and Research (SPR) funds for the Rural Transportation Planning Work Program for a total amount of \$72,500; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission has integrated the transportation planning processes of Planning District 16’s rural and urbanized areas, the latter of which being the responsibility of FAMPO.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the George Washington Regional Commission that it hereby endorses the FY 2021 Rural Transportation Planning Work Program and recommends that it be closely coordinated with the Urban Transportation Planning Work Program carried out under the policy direction of the Fredericksburg Area Metropolitan Planning Organization.

Adopted by the George Washington Regional Commission at its duly called meeting on May 18, 2020, a quorum being present.
