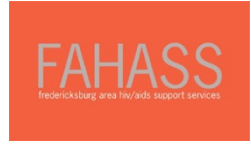

# COVID Emergency Sheltering

- Hotel beds targeted to shelter all unsheltered (March 2020- June 2021)
- Decompression of congregate shelter
- Additional PPE and COVID supplies to shelters
- Partnering with hospital to shelter those COVID+ and unable to safely quarantine in the community

# Keys for Christmas

- Goal: 95 households housed in 90 days
- Oct. 1 - Christmas Eve: Landlords receive a signing bonus equal one month of rent in addition to the regular security deposit and the first month's rent.



# COVID Challenges

- Low vacancy rates paired with low unit turnover due to eviction moratorium has made housing challenging
- Unknown impact of continued COVID spread and eviction moratorium on future homelessness
- Winter shelter planning given challenges above and trickle out of COVID hotel funding



# Future Planning

- Short-term
  - Winter emergency shelter planning
  - Continuous usage and surge evaluation
  - Building community partnerships to address larger economic fallout of COVID-19
- Long-term
  - Identifying creative solutions/partnerships for housing shortage and needs
