- King George is also interested in Coastal Resilience and Trees Fund. Ms. Kinney clarified this fund can be used for maintenance as well as new projects. Mr. Huntsinger offered that Friends of the Rappahannock is happy to support grant writing efforts for this or other funds.
- Caroline is interested in receiving old CRS information and training materials—has had staff turnover since last workshop.
- Ms. Hughes added that there is a CBLP course for elected officials.
- Mr. Williams offered that if CBLP worked with GWRC or another PDC, the CBLP trainings could be added to the WIP scope.
